

Middleware is connectivity software that consists of a set of enabling services that allow multiple applications to communicate. The term middleware is used to describe separate products that serve as the glue between networked applications. For example,



- Database systems to a Web server.

- Migrating mainframe applications to client/server applications providing communication across several systems.
- Providing services such as identification, authentication, authorisation, directories, and security.
- Importing and Exporting data from systems down to files and Excel spreadsheets for creating reports.
